- Please follow all usage instructions when setting up your hammock 'how to' videos/instructions can be found within our site
- The tree, hammock stand or other base used to hang your hammock should be sturdy and strong enough to easily hold all of the weight you are hanging from it. Please also ensure there are no loose overhanging branches or other items which may fall onto the hammock
- Please consider the height you hang your hammock do not hang it higher than you
 would want to fall! Similarly, you should be hanging clear of (not touching) the
 ground when in the hammock
- Do not leave children unattended around or within a hammock, or any of our products
- Not recommended for use by pets
- It is the consumer's responsibility to follow reasonable safety precautions and to consider their own limitations when engaging in outdoor activities
